

AN UPDATE FROM DUNCAN IN UGANDA

I recently received the following email from Duncan Sebachwa, whose church and Joherbson Primary School we support regularly from Cornerstone's Outreach Fund:

"Greetings to all of you and Cornerstone church as well in Jesus' name! Thank you for your constant prayers that lockdown here has been eased and this was breath-taking for all believers of Christ all over the country. Higher institution re-opens next month but for primaries, we hope in January.

Despite the fact that we were in celebrations for churches being opened, yesterday we had a disastrous rainstorm that left many people homeless here in Kibaale- Karuguuza. Unfortunately the roof of our church went off and many things were destroyed by flooding. I just thought that I needed to inform you as soon as possible."

Duncan sent some photographs, which show clearly just how extensive the damage has been.



am pleased to say that approval has been given to send £300 from the church's Outreach Fund to help Duncan and his church with repairs to their building. Do, please, continue to pray for them at this difficult time, as well as for local people who have also suffered loss and flooding.

Please also pray for Pastor Simon Muwereza, who ministers to a very poor community on the outskirts of Jinja, Uganda's second city. During celebrations for his son's wedding recently a fire spread from his neighbour's property and destroyed his home and all the family's belongings.
